- Model practices for virtual, in-person and hybrid international student recruitment and the intentional use of social media for recruitment (content creation, paid advertisement etc..);
- Professional and career development aimed at increasing resiliency, support strategies for mental health, selfcare and mentoring;
- Meaningful cross-campus and cross-industry collaborations beyond international enrollment management to drive the recovery of the international education field;
- Hybrid recruitment and admission practices to reduce our carbon footprint and foster environmental sustainability;
- Creative design and technologies in international enrollment management practices with the use of data to advocate, educate and innovate for the sustainable future of international student mobility;
- Managing legalities, risk, and ethical challenges around international enrollment management and operations during and post-pandemic

Advising and Enrollment in International Education: Information, tools, and training that showcase good practices, developments, research, knowledge, and the use of emerging technologies as they apply to advising and enrollment in all areas of international education.

- Effective use of technology to counsel students through the admission cycle.
- Emerging global trends on test-optional practices for holistic admission
- Measuring effectiveness of digital outreach and advising tools

Innovations in Recruitment and Marketing: Innovations in recruitment and marketing, including digital recruitment, the use of social media, return on investment, communication strategies, branding, public relations or market trends, and data and analysis.

- Creative use of social media tools to engage parents/students in recruitment activities.
- Developing a hybrid pandemic -proof recruitment plan
- Innovative communication journeys for prosective and admitted students to increase yield
- Innovative CRM features to improve processes and leverage technology in admission

Management and Strategy: Management models, policies, and practices in an office or program in international education; principles, methods, and leadership strategies for strategic planning and policymaking to achieve the goals and mission of international education within an institution or organization.

- Successful budgeting, resourcing and financial strategies
- Enrollment forecasting and scholarship modeling in years of increased uncertainty
- Measuring ROI in the digital recruitment landscape

Professional Development: Development of skills and strategies that help international educators achieve career goals, reach leadership potential, and find balance between personal and professional life.

- Building resiliency in international enrollment management
- Mentoring programs for international enrollmemt professionals at various stages in their careers
- Tips on work like balance and strategies for building a professional network when working remotely

Promoting Safety, Mitigating Risk, and Responding to Crisis: Tools, communication processes, compliance, strategies, and planning that campuses and international offices use when faced with a crisis, health emergency (mental or physical), or safety concern in international education.

- Model processes to manage different types of crisis successfully
- Recruiter toolkit and resources for managing risk and safety while recruiting abroad
- Model practices for meaningful conversations with prospective students and parents about risk and safety abroad

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
